Discussed Teacher Grant form- only 1 has been returned so will table that discussion until next meeting when we get more back.

Danielle said we should consider the mascot costume since that was a repeated request from last year. Also assembly flag poles are badly needed.

There was some discussion about the outdoor movie showings and whether or not a license is needed.

Elizabeth asked for a motion to approve the Basketball Championship T-Shirts. LeAnna motioned to approve the purchase, Trisha seconded the motion. All were in favor with the condition that they try to bring the price down closer to \$300-\$400.

Elizabeth asked for a motion to approve the Championship Banners. Trisha made the motion to purchase the banners; LeAnna seconded the motion. All were in favor.
