Missing vaccination notifications have been sent out via email and/or letter. If you have received a notification, please be sure to vaccinate your student as soon as possible and submit the documentation to the nurse. By **November 15th** each year, schools are required to submit student immunization data. For the past several years, Painted Rock Academy has achieved 100% compliance on these reports. Please help us continue to meet this goal. Feel free to contact the school nurse if you have questions.

Please remember that if your child has a fever that is 100 degrees Fahrenheit or greater, he or she will need to stay home from school until it has been 24 hours without a fever and without the use of fever reducing medication (acetaminophen, ibuprofen, naproxen). Aspirin should not be administered to minors with flu symptoms due to the risk for Reye's syndrome, which is potentially fatal. Keep in mind that some other common flu symptoms include body aches, headache, cough, sore throat, and fatigue. If your child is not feeling well, please keep him or her home from school until symptoms improve.
