Notes from the Assistant Principal

I'm thoroughly enjoying my role as Assistant Principal at Painted Rock Academy. I especially appreciate getting to know more of the student population and their parents. One of my responsibilities includes tracking and addressing student discipline. Because we have high expectations for our students and staff, I have compiled a few notes to help you navigate our guidelines for attendance and dress standards. The full policies may be found in the front section of your student planner.

Tardies (pages 10-11 of the student planner):

- School begins at 8:00 a.m.
- A 5-minute grace period is extended for students to be in their seats by 8:05 a.m.
- Students entering through the office at 8:05 or later will need to be signed in by a parent and will be issued a tardy.
- Four unexcused tardies in the same quarter will result in a lunch detention
- Detentions will continue to be issued for every four subsequent tardies.
- Continued unexcused tardies will result in a meeting with administration, then in-school suspension, and eventually out-of-school suspensions.
- Tardies and absences are both considered when determining eligibility to pass to the next grade level and may lead to citation for truancy.



I hope that you find these notes helpful. We hope that our policies help create an environment in which students can learn with fewer distractions and more individual accountability. Please don't hesitate to reach out if you have any questions.

<u>Dress Standard</u> (pages 15-17 of the student planner):

<u>Four</u> dress code citations (K-3rd) or <u>three</u> dress code citations (4th-8th) in one grading period will result in a detention. Here are a few reminders (see planner for full standard):

• Outerwear that may be worn in the building includes the following:

Only plain and solid: white, navy blue, hunter green or light blue

NO Hoodies (this includes a hoodie with the hood down or tucked under)

NOT tied around the waist or shoulders – outerwear may be carried over the bent elbow to take outside to be worn during recess but must be removed when re-entering the building.

- Nails: clear, pale pink, pale beige, or French-style plain nail polish is permitted. No other colors or seasonal designs are allowed. No false nails are permitted.
- Shorts, skirts, and jumpers: Must be <u>no shorter</u> than 4" above the middle of or back of the knee.
- No boots.
- **No leggings.** Students may wear tights/hose in solid neutrals. Footless tights/hose may not be worn.

Born in Holland


Coached basketball for seven years.
