

Campus Safety

Keeping all our students safe on campus is a priority at Painted Rock Academy. To help us know who is authorized to be on campus. please continue to follow these safety procedures:

ALWAYS SIGN IN and get a name badge at the front office when you are on campus. If you come often, you may still obtain an ID lanyard for \$4.00. See Claudia at the front office to have your picture taken.

DISPLAY YOUR NAME/GRADE PLACARD in your windshield when you use the drive-up pickup lane. Additional placards are available at the front desk.

WAIT OUTSIDE the Activity Room if you walk up to pick up your student at the 11:05 or 2:15 dismissal times.

PASS THROUGH THE OFFICE TO THE ART ROOM if you walk up to pick up your student at the 3:15 dismissal.

TO PICK UP FROM BOULDER CLUB, come onto campus through the southwest gate by the basketball court and enter the Multi Purpose Room through the glass doors by the playground.



Board Meetings



The Board of Directors meets on the fourth Thursday of each month unless otherwise posted. All regular meetings are open to the public, and parents are encouraged to

Parent Teacher Conferences are this month,. Children do better in school when their parents are involved in their education. The first quarter conferences are mandatory. Conferences are one way to get involved. Every time you attend a parent/teacher conference, you learn more about your child and strengthen the bond with your child's teacher. So, make parent/teacher conferences a priority and take the following steps to ensure you and your child get the most out of them.

Before the conference:

- Talk with your child: Find out his or her favorite subjects or activities, and ask if there are any concerns he or she would like you to discuss with the teacher.
- Review assignments: Are there some areas where your child really shines and others that might need a little extra work? Discuss both strengths and weaknesses with the teacher.
- Check whether your child should attend: In most cases, the conferences are strictly between the parents and the teachers, so you'll probably need to make childcare arrangements.

The day of the conference:

- Be on time: The conference schedule is tight and teachers need all parents to be on time. If something comes up, notify the teacher as soon as possible. Try to reschedule, even if it has to be a telephone conference.
- Remember that conferences are brief: A typical parent/teacher conference lasts 15-20 minutes. If you need additional time, ask for a follow-up session.
- Keep an open mind: Some parents get angry when teachers discuss trouble spots. Remember these conferences are meant to help you understand your child's school performance.
 Working together with the teacher will help your child succeed.

Afterward:

- Tell your child: After the conference, meet with your child and discuss the teacher's comments. Remember to praise all the things your child is doing well and pass along the teacher's compliments. If you need to, talk about areas that you and the teacher will be working on to help your child improve.
- Follow up: In the days that follow, let your child's teacher know that you are following through
