President: Harkins Summer Fun Pass: Discussion on dates for turn -in and date flyers will be sent home with students. March 7, 2014 will be the date to turn in purchases.

Kristi ordered a vinyl banner made to display our Spring Fling to attach to the fence. Spring Fling is April 12, 2014 from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. The theme for the event is: Country. Our budget is \$400.

Ticket price will be \$.25. Pre-sale price: for 4 for \$1 and day- of- event: 3 for \$1.

Kristi is looking into using wristbands instead of tickets for all carnival rides.

Activities will be: Ninja Obstacle courses, bouncy house, cotton candy, dunk tank, horse shoe and lasso. We will rent a generator to operate all the electrical equipment with 2 extension cords.

Kristi also discusses opportunities for the eighth-graders to work to add money to their budget for their promotion at Spring Fling.

- A mandatory participation in which the eighth-graders will clean up after the spring fling. They will get paid for doing this, but the money will go into their eighth grade promotion fund.
- Face painting. They will use tickets for face painting and whatever amount they receive will also go to their fund.
- The Student Council can sell candy.

Kristi also mentions that the Boulder Club can participate by helping to design a long banner to be displayed on the fence for the public to see. This event will be open to the surrounding community.

Allison Covielle will coordinate the raffle baskets this year for Spring Fling. She will decide the basket theme. Each grade level will have a different theme to decorate their basket. One dollar tickets will be available for sale, date not yet confirmed.

Sondra discussed the Emergency Kits. 50% of students did not bring in an individual Emergency Kit. She is working on the Emergency Classroom Kits which include wastebasket, toilet paper, trash bags, flashlight and bottled waters, etc.

Sondra is also working on flyers for the Science Fair. 5th to 8th graders will participate and ribbons will be given to 1st -3rd place winners. Tentative date is April 23rd in the evening. Location: Multipurpose Room.
