

6th Grade Supply List

Individual Supplies (students are responsible for their own supply throughout the year)

- 1 1-1/2 inch 3-ring binder
- 2 Pkg. wide or college ruled notebook paper (keep one at home until it is needed; you may need to get more throughout the year)
- 5 Composition style notebooks (100 pages; one for each core subject) more may be needed throughout the year, you may want to buy when they are on sale. (No spiral notebooks, they will fall apart)
- 1 Water bottle labeled with student's name
- 1 Pkg. graph paper
- 1 Silent reading book (minimal pictures, no comic-style novels)
- 6 (2) pocket folders (one for each core subject) To keep track of the subjects it may be helpful to purchase different colored folders. No paper folders; they will fall apart!

The following items should fit into a zippered pouch (NO pencil boxes) and brought to each class on a daily basis:

- 6 pre-sharpened #2 pencils (MUST be 6-sided- No mechanical pencils)
- 6 pens 3 red, 3 blue (no click pens, please)
- 4 Highlighters (Each a different color)
- 1 package of 2-4 Expo markers; more may be needed throughout the year
- 1 12-inch ruler for Math and Spalding (No foldable or rolling rulers)
- 1 White eraser and 1 package of pencil top erasers
- 1 poster board, (any color)
- 1 Pair scissors
- 2 Dry-erase markers and eraser (old sock is fine)
- 1 Glue stick
- 1 Pkg. Coloring utensils- pencils, or no bleed markers (4-8 colors)
- 1 Small pencil sharpener that catches shavings
- 1 protractor for Math
- 1 compass (not plastic, please)

The following items are necessary for whole-group use:

- Last Name A-M 3 Boxes of Kleenex
- Last Names N-Z 1 Bottle of Hand Sanitizer
- 1 roll of paper towels, 1 container of disinfecting wipes (for example Clorox®)
